The Manager Material Planning and Scheduling will work with Sales and Production Management to develop and manage forecast for long range material planning while considering current inventory, obsolescence, purchasing lead times and production capacities. The position requires a change agent with a proven track record in high-mix-low-volume manufacturing environments. He/She will provide comprehensive support to optimize inventory stocking levels and meet customer service objectives.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- Manage and develop a team of Demand/Supply Planners.
- Identify and implement systems and process improvement within the supply chain to enable the business to meet or exceed OTD, inventory and revenue metrics.
- Work with Sales and Operations to ensure forecasted revenue, lead local forecast and inventory planning meetings with Operations, Finance and Sales.
- Oversee forecast and sales planning process including coordination of daily tracking.
- Develop forecast and supply program to improve current days of inventory and cash cycle.
- Develop, maintain and analyze output forecasting, load and backlog analysis consistent with sales orders forecast and manufacturing capabilities.
- Assess impact to materials availability and production schedule from customer sales opportunities that may be affecting demand for product over and above plan.
- Drive, promote and develop positive communication with Marketing and Sales to improve forecast accuracy (< 1%).
- Drive all required action to ensure inventory targets (including safety stock levels) approved by Management are met.
- Analyze inventory levels and product demands to determine reorder levels and safety stock that will ensure product availability and minimize inventory cost.
- Work with operations performing value stream analysis to reduce production lead times.
